AGENDA ITEM NO. 3: Consideration, discussion, and possible action to approve meeting Minutes.

Chairman Maloney moved to approve the meeting Minutes from the December 13, 2010 as submitted. The motion was seconded by Alan King, and the motion was approved (5-0).

AGENDA ITEM NO. 4: Presentation, possible action, and discussion regarding an amendment to the Unified Development Ordinance Article 8 Subdivision Design and Improvements and Section 11.2 Defined Terms related to biking, walking, and greenway standards in the subdivision regulations. Jason Schubert further discussed the proposed changes in the subdivision regulations as related to biking, walking and greenway use, which are slated to be presented to City Council at the January 13, 2010 meeting.

meeting. Venessa Garza will also present additional sidewalk and multi-use path projects to discuss at the next meeting.

Subject: CIP sidewalk and multi-use path priorities

Item: Presentation, possible action, and discussion regarding CIP sidewalk and multi-use path priorities.

Background & Summary: The Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Greenways Advisory Board has reviewed and provided a recommendation on CIP sidewalk and multi-use path priorities in the last two board meetings. At the January 10, 2011 meeting, staff proposed bringing back additional multi-use path projects for review and recommendation. After reviewing the list of recommend projects discussed by the Board, staff has a sufficient number of projects to move forward. Attached is a list of those projects with maps for your records. The proposed sidewalk on Luther Street from Jones Butler Road and Marion Pugh Drive has been removed from the list due to status of the road and the need to add curb and gutter in the future. The addition of a sidewalk before that time would not be feasible due to cost. As a reminder, not all of the proposed projects have funding but are being identified for any opportunities that may arise.

Staff is working with the Public Works Department to determine and propose feasible bike lane priorities. This item will come to the Board at a later date. No further action is needed by the Board at this time.



