

Helpful Tips when Parking in Northgate

Below are some of the most common mistakes that result in parking citations:

- Parking at expired meters
- Overstaying the allowed time in the free two-hour spaces
- Parking on an unapproved commercial surface (parking on the grass is not allowed)
- Parking within 30 feet of a traffic control device (such as a stop sign)
- Parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant
- Parking within 20 feet of a crosswalk (marked or unmarked crossings apply)
- Parking in an accessible (handicap) space without displaying the appropriate placard
- Parked facing traffic (vehicles must be parked in the direction of traffic flow)
- Parking in the yard (vehicles must be parked on an approved surface such as asphalt, concrete, or gravel)
- Occupying more than one parking space (vehicles must be parked within the markings)
- Using a bike lane as a loading zone (bike lanes must remain clear at all times)
